Barriers Holding Children Back

Poverty & Dropout Rates

Over 35% of Ugandan children leave school before completing primary education.

Crumbling Infrastructure

Many rural schools lack safe classrooms, clean water, and basic learning materials.

Child Rights Violations

Abuse, neglect, and exploitation remain widespread in vulnerable communities.

Disempowered Families

Parents lack the skills and resources to support their children's learning and well-being.

Whole-Ecosystem Model

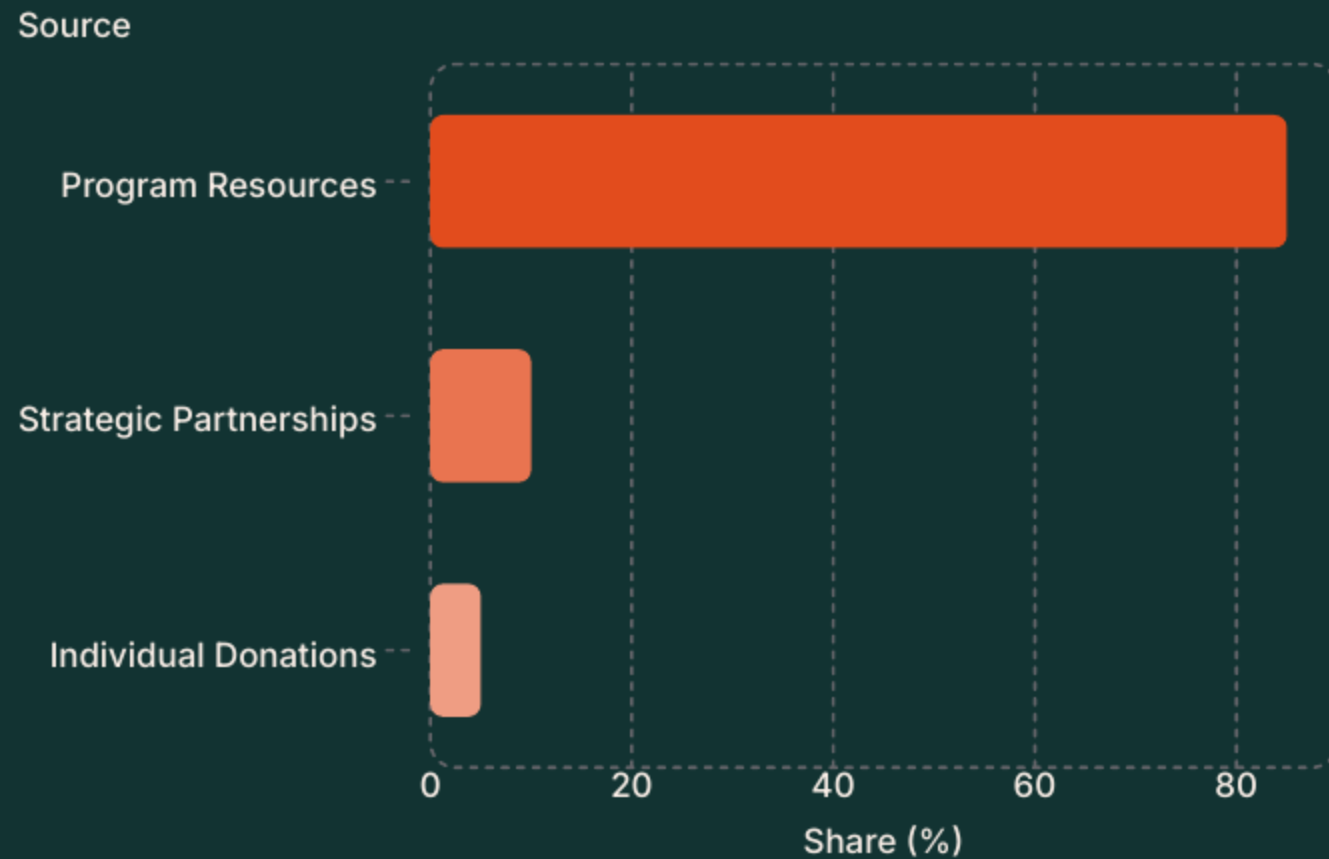
We support the child, teacher, parent, and school simultaneously – not in silos.

How We Are Funded



Program Resources — 85%

Our primary income comes from incubation programs, school partnerships, and in-kind contributions that directly fund activities.

Strategic Partnerships — 10%

Corporate and institutional partners co-invest in community development projects aligned with their CSR goals.

Individual Donations — 5%

Generous donors support child sponsorships and emergency school infrastructure needs.
